



## The fundamentalist propaganda in Montreal

**At the Mosque of Montreal, our Bureau of Investigation has found propaganda advocating sharia Palestinian terrorism and suicide bombings. The organization also operates an elementary school funded in the same building.**

The booklet, entitled *Controversial Questions about Islam and Comments*, made nearly a hundred pages. *The journal* was found in a display at the entrance of the mosque, including that of children attending the school.

"I think it's almost criminal, said Errol Mendes, professor of constitutional law at the University of Ottawa. Basically, the brochure says it's okay to commit terrorist acts! "

The text contains passages to the limit of hate propaganda, according to this expert of Rights and Freedoms.

The author of the booklet is a certain Saeed Ismaeel, a Saudi religious training without contacted by our Bureau of Investigation. Here are some excerpts.

### Good Terrorism

- This is the "believer" who uses "to defend his own life, dignity and property or to defend the oppressed innocent."
- These terrorists are "the most courageous and ferocious, because they consider life as a means, not an end in itself."
- "Maybe that explains the suicide operations by the oppressed Palestinians."

### **Extreme punishment**

- "If an Islamic government is [these laws] out, he done his duty," says the author about the death penalty of 100 lashes for adultery and hand sectioning of a thief.
- The author defends even the death penalty for those who deny Islam, without endorsing it clearly.

### **Jews and genocide**

- "As is the case of all minority groups, Jews were treated well by the majority when they behaved well in their country of origin, but abused when they misbehaved."

### **Compulsory Islamic Veil**

- "A Muslim should recognize that it is the command of Allah, and that she has to bear [the hijab] if it is sincere to avoid the wrath of Allah."

### **Polygamy**

- "It is obvious that there are more women than men in the world. It means that if we have only one wife per man, many women do not have the chance to get married. "

The leaders of the Mosque of Montreal and the Montreal Muslim Schools refused to answer questions from the Bureau of Investigation.

### **And Sherbrooke**

Our Investigation Bureau also reported from fundamentalist propaganda of a visit to the Islamic Cultural Association of Estrie, Sherbrooke main mosque.

Chiheb Esseghaier, accused of plotting to blow up a Via Rail train, attended this place of worship from 2008 to 2010.

Three young radicalized Muslims, the Bureau of Investigation reported missing in October, also prayed at this place.

Such as the Mosque of Montreal, the building of the Association (CEIA) owned by a subsidiary of the Islamic Society of North America.

Here are excerpts from Some Lessons essential for every Muslim, a book found in a display attached to the prayer room.

### **Women's rights**

- "The wife must obey her husband in what is right, especially when he wants it."
- If a man has divorced his wife less than three times, he can take it back. "The consent of the woman is not a condition of validity for his recovery."

### **Gay rights**

- "Homosexuality is a horrible sin."

### **Non-Muslims**

- The "unbelievers" or "all the followers of religions other than Islam," are destined for hell.

Asked about the book, the general secretary of CEIA, Youssef Regragui, ensures that this booklet has been filed at the entrance by a stranger.

"Everyone complained of these works, he said. They have not been approved by our highest authorities. "

It ensures that CEIA complained to the police. Verifications made, the police of Sherbrooke has nothing on this event.

**QUEBEC TAKES THE MATTER "VERY SERIOUSLY"**

Quebec "takes seriously" the revelations of our Bureau of Investigation on the relationship between four Muslim schools and two Islamist organizations suspected of having financial ties to terrorism. In an interview, Education Minister Yves Bolduc said he wanted to "act quickly" to "correct the situation".

Made aware of the situation, the government immediately decided to change the rules for awarding licenses to private schools. The Department intends to file a bill that provides for "security clearance" of school leaders, as the government already does with child care.

Yves Bolduc also said "troubled" by the extracts from the fundamentalist propaganda that our Bureau of Investigation has found at the Mosque of Montreal, which operates a subsidized primary school in the same building in Notre-Dame-de-Grâce.

"As soon as we became aware of your information, there has been an emergency meeting, said Yves Bolduc. Since these are allegations that are criminal in nature, we transferred the information to Public Safety,

which will transfer it to the police so they can make the inquiry "into this propaganda.

## **"Incompatible behaviors"**

Quebec should be able to file in the Room changes to the Private Education Act by spring, according to Yves Bolduc. "They are going to change the criteria for granting and renewal of licenses to private schools, he said. For leaders, that is to say the owners, managers, directors, there will be a judicial authorization to ensure that there is no criminal record or behavior incompatible with the task ".

Among these "incompatible behaviors," Minister cites a criminal record, the dissemination of hate propaganda and membership of an organization linked to terrorism.

Officers or owners of schools that fail this "security clearance" would be asked to leave their duties or to sell their shares to keep or get a permit from the Ministry of Education.

Yves Bolduc said he wanted to act quickly "for the safety of our children." "We hope that with the cooperation of the opposition, we will be able to pass the bill quickly."
